DEADLINE: MARCH 1

FIRST TIME STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- All applicants must apply for admission and be accepted to North Greenville University.
- Applicants must have a high school **GPA of 3.0** overall.
- Applicants must have a score of **1100 on the SAT OR a composite score of 1100/24** or higher on the ACT.

CURRENT STUDENT & TRANSFER STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- All applicants must apply for admission and be accepted to North Greenville University.
- Applicants must have a **minimum university GPA of 3.0**.
- Applicants must submit a copy of their **current year's transcript** (official or non-official are acceptable).
