The T. Walter Brashier & Family Scholarship Fund provides eligible new incoming students with a \$1,000 scholarship that is automatically renewed on an annual basis.

Important Guidelines

- To qualify for this scholarship, a full-time student must be the child of a parent currently serving full-time or bi-vocationally as a pastor or missionary at an Evangelical church or organization.
- A recipient of this scholarship will not be considered for the Southern Baptist Employee's Children Scholarship or the Southern Baptist Missionary Children Scholarship.
- Preference is given to students from the Upstate of South Carolina.
