VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

We are so excited to have you join our family at NGU. During your time on campus, we are here to serve you. If you ever have any questions about health-related questions or needs, please reach out and we will be happy to help.

As you are preparing to come to NGU, please make sure you have received the following vaccines. Additionally, it will be good to go ahead and obtain immunization records. The records must be a copy of the official immunization document or be signed or stamped by a medical professional. Students are able to opt of vaccine requirements through religious or medical exemptions. Incoming and returning students will be contacted in July each summer with information on how to upload immunization records into the collection system.

REQUIRED

1. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella): Proof of TWO DOSES or attach a copy of each of three titers (serologic evidence of immunity) and date.
Dose 1 - given at age 12 months of age or later.
Dose 2 - given at age 4-6 years or later, and at least one month after the first dose.
2. Tetanus-Diphtheria: Booster with Tdap or Td in the last ten years.
3. Meningococcal Vaccine is required. It must cover the MenACWY strain. TWO doses required.

RECOMMENDED

1. Meningitis B strain: Three doses are highly recommended.
2. Varicella: two doses or proof of positive titer (history of disease) from physician
3. Polio: three doses in any combination active or inactive
4. Hepatitis A: Two doses
5. Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis: Four doses of any combination of DTP, DT, DTaP, TD or Tdap
