

Emergency Student Grant Authorization Form

In response to the American Rescue Plan (ARP), the Department of Education has allocated additional funds to North Greenville University through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). These funds are available to eligible, currently enrolled students to assist with educationally related expenses or with emergency costs directly related to the Coronavirus pandemic.

Authorization to apply the Emergency Student Grant to a current balance:

Students are not required to apply the grant to an account balance, but if you would like for the grant funds to remain on your student account to assist with a current or prior semester balance (not earlier than March 2020), you must provide us with authorization to do so. Please simply submit this form by < _____ > and the funds will remain on your account.

If you wish to receive the funds directly to assist with other educationally related expenses or emergency costs related to the Coronavirus pandemic, no further action is needed (do not submit this form). You will receive an email in your NGU email account in the coming weeks letting you know when a check is available for you to pick up at NGUcentral (Neves Hall at the Tigerville campus) or when an ACH direct deposit has been made (as applicable). If you haven't already done so, you may sign up for direct deposit by logging onto my.ngu.edu, navigate to *Students > Student Accounts > Direct Deposit*.
