Vaccine Requirements

We are so excited to have you join our family at NGU. During your time on campus, we are here to serve you. If you ever have any questions about health-related issues or needs, please reach out and we will be happy to help.

As you are preparing to come to NGU, please make sure you have received the following vaccines. Additionally, you will need to upload your immunization records. The records must be a copy of the official immunization document or be signed or stamped by a medical professional. Students are able to opt out of vaccine requirements through religious or medical exemptions. Incoming and returning students will be contacted each summer with information on how to upload immunization records into the collection system.

Required:

- 1. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella):** Proof of two doses or attach a copy of each of three titers (serologic evidence of immunity).
- 2. Meningococcal-ACWY Vaccine:** It must cover the Men ACWY strain. One to two doses depending upon the date received.
- 3. Tetanus-Diphtheria:** Booster with Tdap or Td in the last ten years.
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening questionnaire.**

Recommended:

- 1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis:** Primary series of four (4) doses of any combination of DTP, DT, DTaP, TD or Tdap.
- 2. Hepatitis A:** Two doses.
- 3. HPV:** Three doses.
- 4. Meningitis B strain:** Two doses; highly recommended.
- 5. Polio:** three doses in any combination active or inactive.
- 6. Varicella:** two doses or proof of positive titer (serologic evidence of immunity).

Please consult with your primary care provider for information regarding annual vaccines.
