Position Summary: Candidates who are tenor or baritone with a background and/or professional experience in vocal instruction are preferred. Candidates must have a Christian commitment and the ability to integrate the Christian faith with traditional coursework.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach private voice lessons; Tenor or Baritone preferred.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Master's degree in vocal music or a related field
- Preference will be given to applicants holding a terminal degree
- Experience and a passion for teaching
- Evidence of scholarly potential
- Supports NGU's mission statement and core values, commitment to a Christian lifestyle and character in keeping with biblical model

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Hearing: Hear well enough to teach vocal lessons
- Dexterity: Ability to accompany students preferred
- Mobility: Teach classes, move between departments, and attend meetings across campus.
- Talking: Teaching classes and private lessons.
- Cognitive/Emotional: Ability to critically think and concentrate.
